Adelante Foundation has a twenty year history of success providing micro loans and education to underserved entrepreneurial women throughout Honduras in order to increase resilience, avoid displacement, and reduce inequalities. Adelante activities are implemented by an entirely Honduran team within five different branch offices. Progress is tracked through a robust monitoring & evaluation system to track qualitative and quantitative measurements for internal and external stakeholders. Services are provided on average to 5,000 women and their families annually. By providing small business loans and training to women, cycles of generational poverty are broken and women lead more empowered lives.
